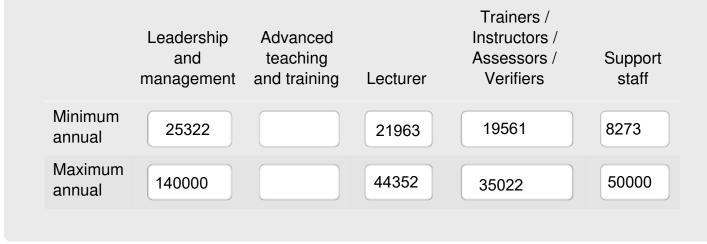



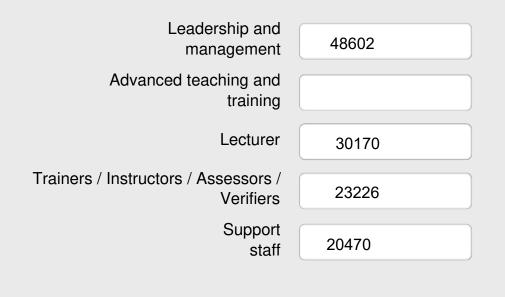


Salary range by staff type

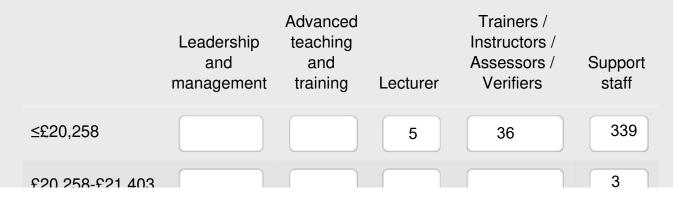

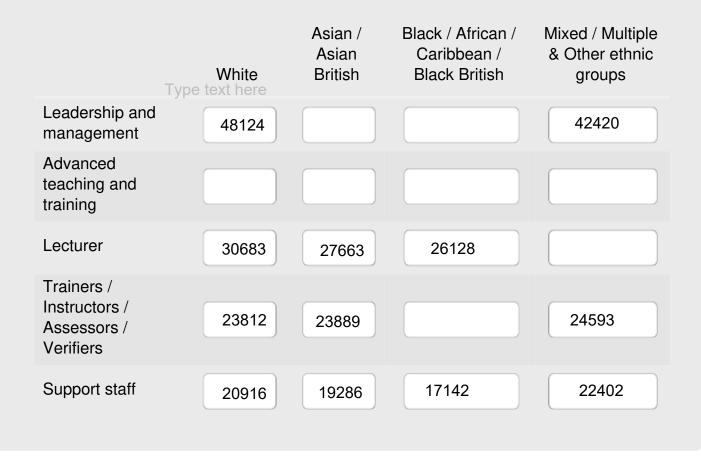
