


For Education

Rated Ofsted Good in 2023, we are proud to deliver our innovative and excellent education, training programmes and courses (including T Levels from 2023) to students of all ages across seven sites.

We have college campuses in Rotherham town centre comprising of our Eastwood, Wentworth and Clifton Buildings, delivering a variety of programmes with a focus on arts and technology, digital health, care as well as our construction hub. Dearne Valley College is just five miles away based in Wath-Upon-Deerne and majors in animal care, land-based industries, sport and e-sports. North Notts College is made up of two campuses in Worksop and Retford, and these specialise in key vocational offerings such as the creative industries, technology and sustainability and education, care and public services.

In 2018, the RNN Group opened the University Centre Rotherham (UCR), a purpose-built Higher Education centre in the heart of Rotherham. The UCR is dedicated to offering high-quality degrees and professional training qualifications. The Group have been delighted with the success of the UCR and the achievements of our students who enjoy studying higher education courses close to home. With the added bonus of lower course fees, the RNN Group became the first education provider to sign up to 'The Bridge Skills Hub', Bassetlaw Council's flagship regeneration project in 2022, which provides a range of exciting Higher and Degree Level Apprenticeships and higher-level qualifications within the centre to allow people of the local and surrounding areas easier access to higher-level skills too.

It offers a unique range of short courses, based across 25 plus sectors of Industry, for those involved in the maintenance and management of fluid power systems and bespoke training packages.

RNN Group delivers skills programmes and courses to adults through the adult education budget to develop the skills needed to grow our local economy.

We offer courses in Digital Skills (including Cybersecurity, Digital Marketing and Networking) Warehousing and Logistics, Engineering and Manufacturing, Construction, Health, Hair and Beauty as well as programmes and training in the Professional Sectors (Business Administration, Team Leading and much more).

We also offer many distance learning courses and higher technical skills to support working adults with their learning.

We work with over 800 employers ranging from small employers to multinational organisations. Our expert skills consultants know how to access funding to support your staff development and have the experience to tailor this to businesses of all sizes.

Apprenticeships are a key part of the RNN Group offering opportunities in business administration and customer service, childcare and education, construction, engineering, hair and beauty, health and social care and motor vehicle.

An Apprenticeship is a fantastic way to recruit enthusiastic employees who become a real asset to your business. A combination of on and off-the-job training ensures that an Apprentice learns the skills that your business requires while gaining a recognised qualification.

Additionally, we offer work placements and traineeships. A traineeship is a skills development programme that includes a work placement. Typically, it will last for under six months but can last from between six weeks up to one year. A work placement is a short-term commitment between employers and students that see our students complete a work placement within your business.

We have been developing our commercial training offering during 2023 for the advantage of employers and individuals. Courses – many of which are funded - include IOSH, NEBOSH, first aid at work, manual handling, business administration, team leading, data protection and data security, maths and English, equality and diversity, counselling skills, mental health first aid, customer service which are a few examples of our offer.

Our two new business centres - Business Centre Rotherham (BCR) at the UCR and 7 Enterprise Way at Dearne Valley College are available for businesses to hire for training sessions, conferences, group meetings and office space both on a short and long term basis.

Finally, we welcome employers both to be part of our employer academies to ensure our curriculum is forward-looking and has a strong practical element, and to our employer forums, in order to listen to employers' needs to deliver on a strong and relevant workforce fit for industry now and in the future.

The NFPC is a world class approved training provider in Workshop supported by in excess of 60 national and international companies who form the NFPCs advisory and strategic planning group who meet three times a year and are fundamental to the centre's success.

The NFPC is the UK's No.1 training provider for Integrated Systems Engineering, offering our services to over 300 major companies both across the UK and Internationally.

The NFPC is a BFPA certified CETOP Education Centre and is an approved training provider for many 'blue chip', industry leading corporations. The Centre employs Training Engineers who have many years of Industry experience, offering support and advice to all who attend our Training Courses. The Centre has 3 fully equipped technical centres with over 3 million pounds worth of up to date equipment supplied to us by our Industry Partners.

Having gained ISO9001-2015 approval, the NFPC is at the forefront of approved training facilities, ensuring a close working relationship with a number of Industry Trade Associations. In addition to the standard package, the Centre offers scope for technical Seminars and corporate events for all organisations.

The NFPC offer's a unique range of short courses, based across 25+ sectors of Industry, for those involved in the maintenance and management of fluid power systems. These range from a basic awareness level in hydraulics, pneumatics or electronics, right through to more advanced control. We offer training on specialist subjects and take a lead in the UK in the provision of Competence Based Qualifications.

They also provide specialist bespoke training programmes, either delivered on your site or at the NFPC, covering specific customer machinery. All their Training Courses are designed to meet the needs of industry, ensuring candidates gain the maximum skills and knowledge for the workplace environment.
