



COURSE LEVELS EXPLAINED

We are proud to offer a range of higher-level and degree qualifications. Your starting point depends on your existing qualifications.



Level 1 and 2

Further Education

Level 1 courses give you the chance to explore a range of areas within your chosen industry, helping you to progress to Level 2 and specialise further. This provides a great foundation to build skills, knowledge and behaviours.

Level 3

Foundation Year

Access to Higher
Education courses
are available if you do
not meet the entry
requirements or are
looking for a career
change. You will study for
one year in preparation to
study a Higher Education
course.

Level 4

Higher National Certificate (HNC)

This is the first year of a degree in a subject and equips you with the knowledge and skills for employment in your chosen field. An external body awards this qualification.

Level 5

Higher National Diploma (HND)/ Foundation Degree

Studying at Level 5 provides you with advanced employability skills by building on practical knowledge of your chosen course.

Level 6

Top-up/Bachelors Degree

Completing a Bachelors Degree, through either three full years of study or a one-year Top-up, provides you with a holistic understanding of your specialist subject.

Level 7


Masters Degree

This one-year course enables you to further specialise in an area once you have completed a Bachelors Degree. This includes a PGCE course as a route into teaching.

Higher Technical Qualifications (HTQ)

HTQs are level 4 and level 5 qualifications, such as Foundation Degrees, Higher National Certificates and Higher National Diplomas.

Learners aged 19 and over may need to pay fees and other costs towards their education up to and including Level 4 study.

Funding

WE ARE EASILY ACCESSIBLE BY BUS, TRAIN AND CAR.

BY BUS

Our colleges are close to many bus routes across South Yorkshire.

Rotherham Interchange bus station, which is conveniently located close to our town centre campus, also provides great travel access to and from surrounding areas.

The Traveline journey planner can help you plan a route and get information about public transport services:

We also run a college bus service, which you can view on the next page.

BY TRAIN

Rotherham College is located a short walk from Rotherham Central train station (RMC). Rotherham Central also operates a tram-train service between Sheffield City Centre and Rotherham.

The closest train station to Dearne Valley College are Bolton- upon-Dearne (BTD), Mexborough (MEX) and Swinton (SWN).

If you travel a lot by train you could benefit from a railcard.

A 16-25 railcard can get you 1/3 off rail travel for everyone aged 16-25 for just £30 for one year or £70 for three years. For more information visit **16-25railcard.**

Mature students can also apply for a one-year railcard, which can be extended with evidence of continuing to study every year.

BY CAR

A number of public car parks are located within easy walking distance of Rotherham College and the Construction Centre including Drummond Street and Percy Street.

Dearne Valley College offers free car parking for students and visitors.

TRAVEL PASSES

There are free travel passes available to students, offering cheaper fares on public transport networks in South Yorkshire.

The 16-18 travel pass allows young people to travel on buses and trams for as little as 80p per journey and half-fare travel on Northern trains. Passes are valid all year round for up to two years.

There are also 18-21 passes available to those who live in South Yorkshire which also offer 80p travel in South Yorkshire to those aged 18 to 21.

There are tickets available for fares in South Yorkshire that range from 1,7, 28 day or annual period to make travelling to college cheaper.

If you are aged over 18, an 18-22 card is available regardless of where you live, for travel in South Yorkshire. The card offers 15% off the price of 1, 7 or 28 day TravelMaster tickets.

Programmes

All programmes are available throughout the academic year with flexible start dates as we recruit learners all year round. This ensures you never 'miss out' on starting a course because there are only one or two opportunities for you to join each year, you don't have the frustration of having to wait months to get started which means you can start your training/learning journey guicker.

Read Write Spell (Non Accredited)

The Read Write Spell English course is aimed to support individuals to begin to learn Basic English skills. You will study 3 hours per week learning how to read and understand short texts on familiar topics accurately and independently, how to read and obtain information from everyday sources, how to spell simple everyday words and learn to write to communicate information using simple grammar structures, capital letters / full stops.

(3 hours learning per week)

Functional Skills English and Mathematics

These courses will help you to build your confidence and independence at home and at work. With sessions from Entry 1, 2 and 3 to Level 1 & 2, these qualifications cover everything from the very basics to more advanced skills.

^{*}Some exceptions may occur - please contact us to find out more.

English: This is a great course for those wanting to build on their ability to write professional letters, reports and CVs. You will study reading skills, spelling, writing skills, punctuation and communication skills for 3 hours per week for 18 weeks.

Maths: This is a great course for those wanting to progress their career or support children with their homework. You will study addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, calculating area, volume and capacity, graphs and charts, fractions, decimals and percentages, problem solving and measure and ratio for 3 hours per week for up to 20 weeks.

IT for Beginners and Essential Digital Skills

IT for beginners is aimed at learners with none, or very little digital skills. It is an ideal program where learners can feel safe to have a go on the computer while learning the basics of what is needed to improve their skills including introduction to using a computer, basic word-processing and an introduction to the internet.

Learners completing this will progress to the Essential Digital Skills

Essential Digital Skills Qualifications, will equip learners with the skills they need make the most of their mobile phone, apps and other digital services. The course ideal for those seeking to develop digital skills to function more effectively in everyday life. It enables and develop learner confidence in using relevant digital tools in today's current workforce environments.

Learners will learn how to keep themselves secure online by learning how to keep personal information safe, while also learning how to make best use of different online resources.

They will also develop skills to use a range of software effectively, including Microsoft Word and Excel. They will also learn how to make basic enhancements to images and also how to troubleshoot basic technical problems that can occur when using a computer.

Sector Based Work Academies (SWAPs) and Pre-Employment Training Programmes

These intensive employment focused courses are designed to helpmeet employers' immediate and future recruitment needs as well as to recruit a workforce with the right skills to sustain and grow their business.

Delivery consists of:

- pre-employment training relevant to the needs of the business and sector
- a guaranteed job interview (where applicable)
- Teamwork, interview techniques and job applications.

We work successfully with DWP and local employers to tailor the course to meet the needs of the labour market.

This means prospective employees have a better understanding of the role, and employers are confident as to the suitability of the candidates applying for work.

We know the system works and people have moved into sustainable employment having completed a SWAP with us.

These programmes are available throughout the academic year, the vocation depends on which employer we work with.

Careers Pathway (19 - 24 year olds) / Preemployment Training

This course is aimed at young adults who need help and support on the journey to starting work. It will provide confidence and essential skills needed to prepare them for the next level. While completing this programme, learners will develop the knowledge, understanding and essential skills employers look for in employees.

Additionally, learners will study changing mind-set, confidence building, transferable skills, social skills, employability skills, job search/computer skills, CV writing, job applications, problem solving at work, working with others, motivational skills, communication skills, a range of activities that will help interaction with others and stretch and challenge.

Getting Into...

These 'getting into...' courses are aimed at adults who need help and support on the journey to starting work. It will provide confidence and essential skills needed to prepare them for the next level or employment.

While completing this programme, learners will develop the knowledge, understanding and essential skills employers look for in employees

What Are Essential Skills For Employers?

These range from familiar 'key skills' such as team working, independent learning and problem solving, to more tricky-to-measure skills such as:

- an appreciation for appropriate behaviour and dress
- appropriate interpersonal skills
- communicating
 with professional
 colleagues/peers and/or
 hierarchical seniors
- supporting other employees, personal manners and behaviours
- understanding work practices and how different roles and departments function within an organisation.

These courses will also include the basic fundamentals required to be successful in today's job market.
