Our ALS Team is also well-equipped to help you apply for DSA (Disabled Students' Allowance). This is an additional avenue of support you can explore.

For day-to-day work, like assignments and communication, you'll also be using Google Classroom. Think of these two as a team: My Progress Tracker shows you the big picture of your progress, while Google Classroom is where you'll handle your daily tasks.

Student Finance (Continued)

Some students may cover their tuition fees independently or through their employers.

However, for most Higher Education students pursuing HNCs, HNDs, Foundation Degrees, Bachelor's Degrees, Top-ups or Master's programmes, the typical route involves applying for a Tuition Fee Loan from Student Finance England (SFE).

Additionally, they may be eligible for Maintenance Loans and Childcare Grants from SFE. You can find comprehensive details and start the application process at **www.gov.uk/student-finance.**

For students enrolled on other Adult (19+)/Higher Education programmes like the Level 4 Diploma in Counselling, you can explore the option of applying for an Advanced Learner Loan at www.gov.uk/advanced-learner-loan.

We understand that not all students may have access to Tuition Fee Loans, and that's why we offer flexible repayment options to accommodate your needs.
